2016-15.hhs	To approve this Interlock Agreement by and between the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) and the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation.  The AAA shall develop, submit to DSHS for approval, and implement an area plan in accordance with DSHS guidelines. The area plan shall provide for a comprehensive and coordinated community-based system of services for older individuals living in the AAA planning and service area. A budget supporting the area plan services, goals and objectives shall be developed and submitted to DSHS/ALTSA annually for the period January 1- December 31.
