	disclosure was in violation of the Council's Code of Professional Responsibility at Tribal Code sections 1-8-6, 1-8-	
	20(c)(1), and $1-8-20(d)(2)$, (3). The public disclosure by	
	Councilmember Marchand of confidential, privileged	
	information gained by virtue of holding Council office was not	
	in dispute at the investigative hearing. While Councilmember	
	Marchand did not explicitly intend to commit an ethical	
	violation or to do harm, his conduct nevertheless violated	
	Council's Code of Professional Responsibility. Also, this	
	violation was an offense to the integrity of Council itself	
	regardless of the impact on, or opinions of, any other	
	individuals who may have been implicated in the disclosure.	
	Having found the facts presented in the investigative hearing do	
	support a finding of unethical conduct, the Rules Committee	
	also makes the following recommendations for disciplinary action to the full Colville Business Council pursuant to Tribal	
	Code section 1-8-30(1)(1):	
	Councilmember Marchand should receive a 60 day suspension	
	from his duties as a Councilmember, without pay. Further, he	
	should be required to receive in-person certified training on	
	rights to privacy and keeping confidentiality before being	
	permitted to participate in deliberations involving confidential	
	material. Further, he should be required to return to the Colville	
	Business Council any documents currently in his possession of	
	a confidential nature. Further, any additional violations of	
	confidentiality by Councilmember Marchand of the Council's Code of Professional Responsibility may be acted upon by the	
	Code of Froressional Responsibility may be acted upon by the	

	Rules Committee via a simple vote, without the process normally afforded in Tribal Code, and are subject to immediate expulsion from the Colville Business Council.
