The proposed funding would provide for planning of display area, design of kiosks representing the history of the fish, people, and lands prior to construction of Chief Joseph Dam, as well as outdoor sculptures depicting resident fish that travelled up the Columbia River. This project would provide for education opportunities for schools K-12 throughout Eastern Washington to learn about the tribe and its cultures. The Chief Joseph Fish Hatchery will collaborate with Colville Tribes History & Archaeology Department, USBR, Corp. of Engineers, Bonneville Power Administration, and downstream Public Utility Districts in the various phases of the planning process. This recommendation is primarily for authorization for the drafting and submittal of this grant, whereas this action authorizes the Chairman or designee to sign all pertinent information related to this document.
