Article 11 of this same treaty state, "This treaty shall be obligatory upon the contracting parties as soon as the same shall be ratified by the President and Senate of the U.S. 2. 1894 Agreement. In August 1894, Congress ratified the Yakama agreement in which the Yakamas ceded the article 10 reservation after they were assured that the Wenatchi Tribe would receive reservation lands in other locations, there they still lived within their aboriginal territory. 3. It has been one hundred and fifty-six (156) years (1859) to Present) since the ratification of the treaty by the President and U.S. Congress and the government still have not satisfied the contracted obligation of providing a reservation for the Pisquouse (also known as the P'Squosa or Wenatchi) Tribe. 4. In 1951 the Indian Claims Commission Docket 224 resulted from the petition of the Colville Tribes of the Colville Reservation to adjudicate the aboriginal territory of the Colville Tribes including the Wenatchi. The Commission ruled that although much of their aboriginal
