WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Rules Committee to approve the following findings of the Rules committee following the Investigative Hearing regarding Ethics Case No. RC-01-2013: The Rules Committee finds that the facts presented support a finding of unethical conduct by Benjamin E. Marchand, Jr. from the Colville Business Council, based upon a violation of the ethical standard set out in the Council's Code of Professional Responsibility, Colville Tribal Code section 1-8-20 (d) (3), by violating the Colville Business Council's credit card policy in a manner constitution misfeasance for unauthorized purchases made on Mr. Marchand's Tribal credit card. Furthermore, to approve the following disciplinary action for Benjamin E. Marchand Jr., pursuant to Colville Tribal Code section 1-8-30 (l) (1) and based upon a finding of fact that Mr. Marchand violated an ethical standard set out in the Council's Code of Professional Responsibility, Colville Tribal Code section 1-8-20 (d) (3): Mr. Marchand shall be expelled for the duration of his term from the Colville Business Council, effective immediately, and; Mr. Marchand shall be ordered to pay restitution of eighteen unauthorized credit card purchases made which were the subject of the original complaint filed in this matter.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Colville Business Council, meeting in a SPECIAL SESSION this 6<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2014 acting for and in behalf of the Colville Confederated Tribes, Nespelem Washington, do hereby approve the above recommendation of the Rules Committee.

The foregoing was duly enacted by the Colville Business Council by a vote of **10 FOR 3 AGAINST 0 ABSTAINED**, under authority contained in Article V, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation, ratified by the Colville Indians February 26, 1938, and approved by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs on April 19, 1938.
